
The Palmer Drought Severity Index shows Glasscock County to be abnormally dry. No public systems will be notified.

There were no wasteful practices for the month of March 2025.

For the Manager's report Rhetta informed board of a new wind turbine farm being developed on the northeast corner of Glasscock County and into Sterling and Howard counties. A representative from Forrest Creek Wind Farms stated some of the proposed turbine locations will need a grounding well to release electrical currents in the event of a thunderstrike. Rhetta also informed the board of legislative bills to include SB7, ADA compliance of the District, to include website, and audio-visual recordings of District meetings.

In other business, Rhetta discussed a sponsorship for the TAGD Groundwater Summit, spacing issues of the office, and the need for a new filing cabinet. All topics were tabled. Rhetta also informed the board about Black Plumbing quote to replace cast iron pipes which have been a long standing problem. Repairs are scheduled to begin March 19<sup>th</sup> and the office will be without water for approximately 2 days until repairs have been complete.

With no other business, Russell Halfmann made a motion to adjourn, Seconded by Lane Halfmann. Motion passed and meeting adjourned at 9:59 am.
