



- Complete one permit application for each well.
- A \$250 deposit is required for **each** permit application. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 4] _____
- If no deposit is made, permit application will be considered administratively incomplete and will not be presented to the Board for consideration of approval. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 4] _____
- Well locations, according to GPS, must be within 30 feet of the proposed well location. If drilled location exceeds 30 feet, deposit will be forfeited. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 9] _____
- This permit application shall remain valid for four (4) months from the approval date. It shall thereafter become void unless an extension has been requested and approved during the first four (4) month period. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 11] _____
- A drilling log must be sent to the Glasscock Groundwater Conservation District within six (6) months of permit approval. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 4] _____
- If no drilling log is turned in to the District by postal mail, email, fax or in person, deposit will be forfeited. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 4] _____
- No well shall be drilled nearer than six hundred sixty (660') feet from the nearest property lines. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 7] _____
- Permit must be approved by the Board **before** drilling can begin. [GGCD Rules & By-Laws; Rule 3 & 6] _____
