The Glasscock Groundwater Conservation District will hold a public hearing at 9:00 am on September 9, 2026, in the District office located at 132 N. Main, Garden City, Texas to consider adopting the proposed 2027 FY budget and adopting the proposed 2026 tax rate of \$0.005255 per \$100 of value. The proposed tax rate would increase total taxes in Glasscock Groundwater Conservation District by 3.32%.
