



## GLASSCOCK GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

### TAXPAYER IMPACT STATEMENT

PURSUANT TO SECTION 551.043© OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE

The Texas Legislature amended the Texas Government Code SS 551.043 (House Bill 1522, 2025) to require governmental bodies to include in a notice of an open meeting in which its budget will be discussed or adopted, a taxpayer impact statement showing, for the median-valued homestead property, a comparison of the property bill in dollars pertaining to the property for the current fiscal year to an estimate of the property tax bill in dollar for the same property for the upcoming fiscal year.

Glasscock Groundwater Conservation District intends to propose a budget at its August 12, 2026, meeting for the District's 2027 fiscal year, which is intended to be adopted at its September 8, 2026 meeting.
